Introduction to NSS

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is an Indian government-sponsored public service program conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India. Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year in 1969. Aimed at developing students personalities through community service, NSS is a voluntary association of young people in Colleges, Universities, and at +2 level working for a campus-community (esp. Villages) linkage.


Later Team Yamuna started the event at 6'o clock sharp with Flag hoisting followed by, Prartana Geethe, NSS

In the survey we found out the main problems which they face are as follows, No Proper Medical Facilities, No Pharmacy, no proper pensions given for the retired employees, need improvement in Government Schools like no proper washrooms, seatings for students and lack of cleanliness, No Public Restrooms. We also found out that the availability of emergency responses is low.

At 12 PM the survey by all the teams were done, then at 1 PM everybody reached Yediyur where the lunch was scheduled for all the volunteers and staff. At 1:30 PM Lunch Serving was started and by 2:15 PM the Lunch Break was winded up.

After that at 2:30 PM Team Ganga organised, a sport called Lagori where all the teamsparticipated and enjoyed the game.
