Blood should be accepted only from voluntary, non-remunerated, low-risk, safe and healthy donors. Replacement of donors should be phased out.

The students and faculties participated voluntarily in this cause and this effective awareness campaign was created among the student’s community well in advance, as a result, **813 units of Blood were collected.**
