Welcome Address:

A brief welcome address and Profile reading was done by Ms. Lakshmi Priya from 3rd semester MBA at 11.00 am.

Introduction and Acknowledgments:

At 11.00 am, Mr. S Kiran initiated the session by introducing himself to the students and gave a brief introduction about the session.

Session commenced from 11.05 am:

Mr. Kiran began by expressing his gratitude to his alma mater and emphasized the role REVA Business School played in shaping his professional journey. He contextualized his talk within the broader framework of professional growth, drawing connections between academic foundation, industry readiness, and personal development.

The talk was structured around the following thematic areas:

1. Challenges in the Early Career Phase

Mr. Kiran elaborated on the typical hurdles encountered by fresh graduates, including limited industry exposure, skill gaps, and initial rejections. He underscored the importance of resilience, adaptability, and strategic self-improvement during this transitional phase.

2. Progress through Incremental Learning

Using personal narratives, he illustrated how consistent efforts, upskilling, and experiential learning facilitated his gradual rise in the corporate hierarchy. He emphasized that career advancement is often nonlinear and requires persistence and a willingness to evolve.

3. Attitude, Learning, and Relationships

A significant portion of the session focused on attitudinal competencies. Mr. Kiran highlighted three core attributes:

- A positive and proactive mindset
- An openness to continuous learning
- The ability to build and sustain meaningful professional relationships

These, he noted, were instrumental not just in securing opportunities, but also in fostering long-term success.

4. Trends and Opportunities in the Healthcare Sector

Mr. Kiran provided a concise yet insightful overview of the healthcare industry, particularly post-pandemic developments. He touched upon emerging technologies, digital healthcare innovations, and the growing demand for strategic business development roles within the sector.

5. Advice for Aspiring Professionals

The talk concluded with actionable recommendations for students preparing to enter the workforce:

- Stay informed about industry trends and evolving skill demands
- Cultivate soft skills along with domain knowledge
- Embrace failures as learning experiences
- Leverage internships and networking to build early exposure






