At 1:55 pm, Mr. Mourya G R initiated the session by introducing himself to the students and expressing gratitude to Dean Shubha Ma'am for the opportunity.

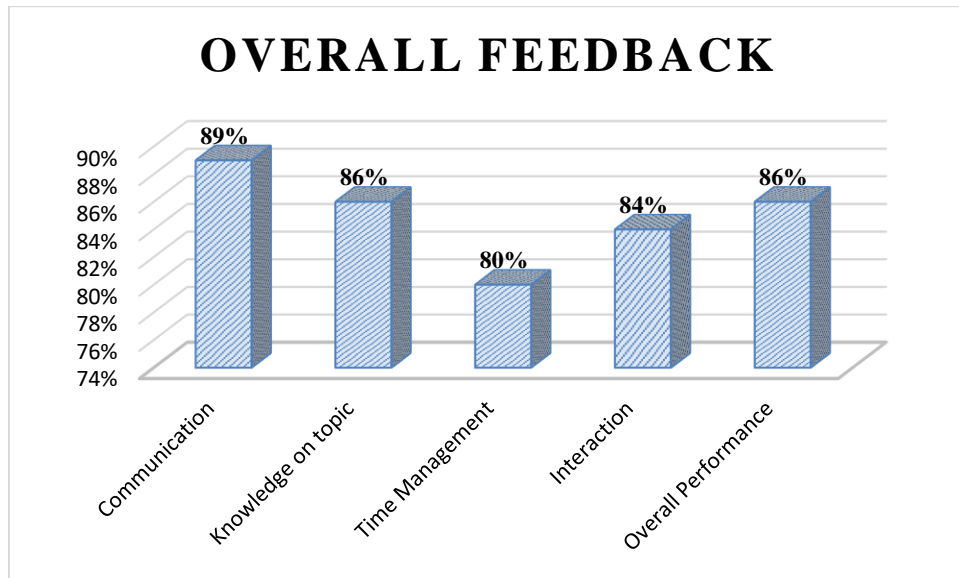
